How to perform a 24-Hour Urine Collection

- 1. Bring slip to lab and pick up empty jug. Ask at the lab if the sample needs to be refrigerated.
- 2. Choose a day that will give you most flexibility and privacy (many people choose Sunday)
- 3. Upon awakening, discard the first urine sample (Day #1).
- 4. Collect all urine the rest of that day, night and include the first urine sample the next morning (Day #2).
- 5. Return jug to the same lab that gave you the jug.
- 6. Depending on what is being measured, it may take up to a week or longer for your clinician to have the final results.
